

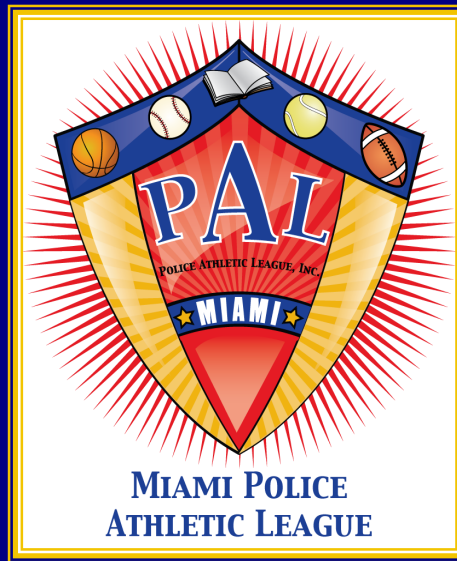

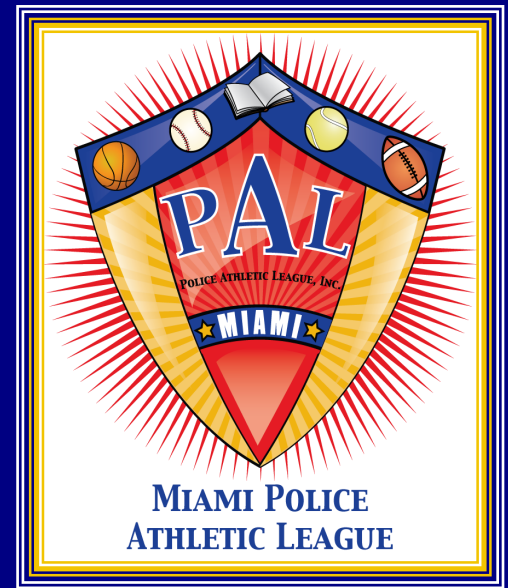
As a registered non-profit, **Miami PAL** relies on the generosity of extraordinary citizens and corporations to provide the resources to keep our youth active, productive and safe.
